It immensely helps in identifying one's areas of weakness and strength by analysing the performance in the examination and beating the competition with a strategy.

How does MASET help the students in Pursuing the STEM curriculum?

- MASET aims to bring together the most talented secondary students in a friendly competition of the highest level.
- MASET does not lead directly to career benefits; instead, it provides a stimulus to begin a career in science or mathematics and undertake a lifelong journey into exciting intellectual challenges.
- The MASET Olympiad is a celebration of the very best in school-level science and mathematics. Even beyond the scope of the examinations, Olympiad problems provide intellectual stimulus and unique opportunities for teaching and learning Mathematics and Science.
- It gives students a chance to sharpen their skills by tackling a number of problems at a difficulty level that they are not likely to encounter in their classrooms.
- The Olympiads do not just test the student's concepts but the application of those concepts in a time-bound environment.



Examination pattern (50 MCQ questions -60 Minutes)

MASET will be conducted for the students of grades 8,9 and 10 with their respective class science and Mathematics syllabus provided by IIS. The question paper consists of 50 Multiple choice questions (MCQ), 25 questions from science and 25 questions from Mathematics, all questions carry equal marks, and there shall be a Negative mark for every wrong answer. 1/4 will be deducted from marks scored for every incorrect answer.

Awards and rewards

IIS will honour outstanding students with Awards that play a significant role in boosting students' morale after they achieve something significant. Prizes for Olympiad winners include medals, cash rewards, certificates of merit, etc. Above all, the proud feeling of representing the state/country at the national or international level is the best reward for every student as it pushes them to scale to greater heights.

In each category, the awards are as follows.

1ST PRIZE : QAR 1500, GOLD MEDAL, AND CERTIFICATE OF MERIT
2ND PRIZE : QAR 1000, SILVER MEDAL AND CERTIFICATE OF MERIT
3RD PRIZE : QAR 500, BRONZE MEDAL AND CERTIFICATE OF MERIT

Attractive prizes, including certificates, for the top ten rankers in each category.

The award ceremony will be held at Ideal Indian School Abu Humour Doha Qatar.


How to register?

Students can register online at www.idealschoolqatar.com/maset-2024 by completing the registration form and paying a fee of QAR 30. Alternatively, students may download the registration form and submit the filled-in form to the Ideal Indian School office by 3 PM on 10th October 2024. Group registrations will be accepted only at participating schools, where information about MASET will be displayed.

Registration forms will be accepted along with the fee on weekdays (Sunday to Thursday) between 7 AM and 3 PM, and on Saturdays between 8 AM and 11:30 AM.

STUDENT GUIDELINES

- The MASET is open for students in grades 8, 9 and 10. Students currently pursuing these classes can appear for the examination.
- Students must complete the registration duly signed by the school principal if they appear from the school.
- MASET will be with 50 MCQ questions for 50 marks with Negative marks. $\frac{1}{4}$ mark will be deducted for every incorrect answer.
- All students shall reach the examination center 30 Minutes before the commencement of the examination. No student will be allowed after 9.45A.M
- The syllabus for all exams aligns with the regular academic syllabus of the student, in accordance with their educational level irrespective of their educational board, as a result of which students of any board can appear for the examination. Please download the syllabus from the school website, www.idealschoolqatar.com
- The MASET registration process is mandatory for any student who wishes to participate in the exams. Students are required to complete the registration process for the exam in order to be able to appear for the same. Students can either opt to register through their respective schools for the Olympiad exam.
- The MASET registration process includes various steps such as filling in the application form, payment of the requisite application fee, etc. It is advised that students register in advance for MASET 2024 in order to avoid any last-minute hassles. Complete details about the registration process for MASET can be found below.
- Students can register from their school or register individually on the official website. The registration can be simply done by logging into the official website given above. Students need to pay a registration fee of **QR 30**.
- The registration process is quite simple; should anyone need guidance and assistance can call the contact numbers given.
- The exams will be held offline at Ideal Indian School- Doha, Qatar.



STUDENT GUIDELINES

- The language-The entire process of resource distribution, along with the exams, is carried out in English.
- Pattern-The exam papers are set in an MCQ format to help the student get used to the pattern, preparing them for participation in competitive exams in the future.
- Number of questions: Overall, there are 50 questions, including both Maths and Science. Weightage of marks: Each correct answer carries 'one mark,' and for an incorrect answer deducts '1/4' of the marks.
- The complexity of the question papers depends upon the class. For each class, questions are prepared considering their knowledge, ability, and reasoning capacity.

The Olympiad will be held as per the following schedule:

- Students must report at the allocated exam center at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the exam.
- Students will be allowed entry into the exam hall 15 minutes before the commencement of the exam to enable them to settle down and fill in their particulars in the OMR.
- Students will not be allowed entry into the exam hall 10 minutes after the commencement of the exam.
- No extra time will be provided to such candidates to complete the exam.
- Students may leave the exam hall only after the completion of the exam time.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the exam hall while the exam is in progress without the permission of the invigilator.
- Students will be given 60 minutes to complete the exam.

GENERAL

- Students may use the question paper for doing rough work.
- No student is permitted to carry any textual material - printed or written, bits of paper, calculator, mobile phone, any electronic device, etc. in the exam hall.



STUDENT GUIDELINES

- Any candidate found using unfair means may be expelled from the examination center. In case the use of unfair means is found after the exam is over, the result of the student(s) may not be declared, and they will not be eligible for any award or certificate.
- The syllabus for the exams will be available on the school website for details, please visit www.idealschoolqatar.com.
- The results are made available for one on the official website; these can be easily accessed by entering the student's roll number on the portal, and the details, along with participation certificates, are made available on the very same portal. Should the student hold distinct merit, the prizes are mentioned there.
- Rewards- believes in catering to students' educational needs in the best way possible, besides which we also want to encourage them; students are hence rewarded based upon their meritorious performance in the test. The list of amazing rewards is available on the website.
- Feedback report-All the participating students are provided with a detailed feedback report so that they can analyze their performance and improve upon it.
- Parents/guardians will not be allowed entry into the exam centers.
- The admit cards, in duplicate, are made available to students as under – These have been couriered to respective schools, and – These will be uploaded on our site, www.idealschoolqatar.com by the last week of October 2024.
- Students may print the admit cards issued to them. Students may collect their admit cards (in duplicate) by either of the above modes, paste their color passport-size photographs on both copies and get them attested (signed and stamped) by school authorities.
- The admit cards carry details of the venue, address, and time of the exam. Students must carry a copy of their admit cards to the test center.
- Students may not be allowed to appear in the Olympiad in the absence of admit cards with photographs.
